Advancing Youth Development (AYD) is a 30-hour course offered by Youth Development Training and Resource Center, based on curriculum from the Center for Youth Development and Policy Research, Academy for Educational Development and the National Network for Youth. The course is designed for youth workers, supervisors, agency directors, and youth advocates who interact with youth workers and adolescents. New Haven B.E.S.T. (**B**uilding **E**xemplary **S**ystems for **T**raining **C**ommunity **Y**outh **W**orkers) offers this course as the nationally designated site in Connecticut. The course will be facilitated by **Denise Page**, AYD graduate and lead facilitator of AYD for more than a decade. She served as a Supervisor of the Anti-Crime Youth Council and as a member of the White House Council on Youth and Violence.

Seven sessions include: Historical Development of Youth Work, Achieving Youth Outcomes, Nurturing Youth Competencies, Planning Developmentally and Culturally Responsive Programs, Assessing Youth Outcomes, and Professional Competencies of Youth Workers

A *letter of commitment from an appropriate supervisor* must accompany the registration and payment to complete the registration process. The letter should indicate awareness and approval for the training dates, registrant's experience in youth programming, and the need to attend all seven sessions.

Registration and Fees:

Fee per person is \$175.00. Fee includes: a breakfast, lunch (first and last day), curriculum notebook, supplemental resource guide and certificate of completion.
