Advancing Youth Development (AYD) is a 30-hour course offered by Youth Development Training and Resource Center, based on curriculum from the Center for Youth Development and Policy Research, Academy for Educational Development and the National Network for Youth. The course is designed for youth workers, supervisors, agency directors, and youth advocates who interact with youth workers and adolescents. New Haven B.E.S.T. (**B**uilding **E**xemplary **S**ystems for **T**raining Community Youth Workers) offers this course as the nationally designated site in Connecticut. The course will be co-facilitated by Alexis Bivens, qualified trainer and former AYD graduate from the McGivney Community Center in Bridgeport, CT.

Seven sessions include: Historical Development of Youth Work, Achieving Youth Outcomes, Nurturing Youth Competencies, Planning Developmentally and Culturally Responsive Programs, Assessing Youth Outcomes, and Professional Competencies of Youth Workers

A **letter of commitment from an appropriate supervisor** must accompany the registration and payment to complete the registration process. The letter should indicate awareness and approval for the training dates, registrant's experience in youth programming, and the need to attend all seven sessions.
